The expressive nature of art and artistic ways of thinking complements the scientific, mathematical and theoretical subjects well. At Holy Trinity, year ten pupils create two dimensional, drawn, painted + mixed media studies and also work in three dimensional sculptural form. Past themes have included; High Colour + Photorealism, Cityscape + Street art and Distortion + DeStijl. Year eleven pupils specialise further to create a substantial and personalised final art work. We are proud of our achievement and in 2015 over 82% of pupils gained an A*-C in art. The course relies on 60% coursework and 40% examination.
