APOSTROPHE



There are two types of apostrophe:

- The **possessive** apostrophe
- The **omission** apostrophe

This is when we miss out letters from words to shorten them, forming a 'contraction'. E.g.

- do not becomes don't.
- could not becomes couldn't.
- cannot becomes can't.
- will not is *irregular* and becomes won't.
