



WHAT SHOULD I STUDY?

At Holy Trinity Academy, we offer our students the opportunity to study 3 x A Levels. We are very fortunate in that because we operate a small Sixth Form, then our class sizes is much smaller than those of other Sixth Forms. You can expect to be in a class of between 6 and 15 students. This means that our students, on average, have more time with their subject tutors.

Which A Level courses you choose will then depend on what your plans are for when you finish Year 13 and what your academic strengths are. Some students select the Sciences / Mathematics. Some select the Humanities (e.g.: History, Geography and Religious Studies). Others select a mixture of the two in order to keep their options open.

The curriculum is well matched to the needs and aspirations of our students, who choose from a wide range of recognised AS and A2 level subjects, including those most valued by the established universities. The purposeful ethos and the excellent facilities promote an independent approach to learning. Progress is closely monitored and well focused support is provided to help our students to obtain results of which they can be proud.
