




Mass Prayers and Responses

3 Gloria

Priest: Glory to God in the highest ...

6 Before the Gospel reading

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Staff: And with your spirit.

Priest: A reading from the holy Gospel according to
Luke

Staff: Glory to you, O Lord.

Priest: After he had finished speaking, he said to
Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower
your nets for a catch."

Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked
hard all night and have caught nothing, but at
your command I will lower the nets."

When they had done this, they caught a great
number of fish and their nets were tearing.
They signalled to their partners in the other
boat to come to help them. They came and
filled both boats so that the boats were in
danger of sinking. When Simon Peter saw this,

7 Invitation to Prayer

Bidding Prayers

Staff: Blessed be God for ever

Staff: Blessed be God for ever

Priest: Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

Staff: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

8 Preface Dialogue

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Staff: And with your spirit.

Priest: Lift up your hearts.

Staff: We lift them up to the Lord.

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

Staff: It is right and just.

Priest: The mystery of faith.

Staff: When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.

11 Doxology / Amen

Priest: Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of



the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever.

Staff: Amen

12 Our Father



Priest: At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say ...

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Priest: Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil, graciously grant peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be always free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Staff: For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.

15 Sign of Peace

Priest: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

Staff: And with your spirit.

[To each other: **Peace be with you**]



16 Lamb of God

17 Invitation to Communion
