INTRODUCTION

It is the policy of the Governing Body of Holy Trinity Academy that all students wear our distinctive school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event or outside normal school hours (unless otherwise stated). A complete list of acceptable items for uniform can be found in this policy.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Our policy for school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Provides a sense of community and belonging
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Creates peer equality in terms of appearance
- Is designed with Health & Safety in mind

GENERAL UNIFORM

Blazers must be worn at all times unless permission is given to remove them by a member of staff. No form of 'hoodie', tracksuit top or sports top must be worn as an outer coat to or during school, it will be confiscated and parents will be asked to come in and pick it up. The Blazer will become the outer coat whilst in School.

Trousers must be sensible tailored school trousers. Not jeans or fashion trousers that are too tight have pockets, belts, buckles or other ornamentation. Trousers length must be below the ankle. Skirts should be a decent length, no higher than just above the knee.

Outer coats should be black or navy only.

Students should choose one option from the two options listed below.

Option 1

Navy Blazer with school badge
White shirt with reverse collar
Jubilee tartan pleated skirt
Red V-neck pullover
Black plain flat shoes, no boots
Pumps, trainers or canvas shoes
Navy long socks or tights
No trainer or ankle socks
Apron or overall

Navy Blazer with school badge
White shirt
School approved grey trousers
Red V-neck pullover
School striped tie
Black plain flat shoes, not boots,
pumps, trainers or canvas shoes
Grey or black socks
Apron or overall

PE Shorts – these must sit just above the knee in length, they must not be tight fitting or rolled up in any way.

MOUTH GUARDS AND SHIN PADS

Due to health and safety, parents must provide students with mouth guards for use when playing hockey and shin pads for use when playing football and hockey. This is compulsory.

JEWELLERY & MAKE UP

Jewellery should not be worn. If students have pierced ears, a maximum of two small plain gold or silver studs (one in each ear) on lower lobe is allowed. Nose studs, upper ear piercings and facial piercings, including tongue studs, are not acceptable. A recent piercing is not a valid reason for wearing unacceptable jewellery. The use of plasters as a means of covering up is not acceptable. No rings, bracelets, or chains.

No make-up or any cosmetic products for example - false tan, tinted moisturiser, tinted eyebrows/eyelashes or false eyelashes are allowed. This list does not cover all the cosmetic appearance enhancers, so please contact the school before you choose to use anything that we may deem cosmetic. Students will be given sanctions and asked to remove any of the above. A bigger sanction will be given for applying cosmetics that cannot be removed instantly.

Students who arrive wearing make-up or nail varnish will be told to remove it before they are allowed in class. For safety reasons fingernails should be kept to a reasonable length. False or acrylic nails are not acceptable under any



circumstances.

HAIRCUTS

We appreciate that fashions in haircuts are constantly changing and schools have to cope with trends. However, students should have hair of

one 'natural colour', no dyed hair, nostreaks, no etched or engraved designs or cuts or styles that are extreme or below a **Number 2**. Long hair should be clean, tidy and be tied back at all times in practical subjects

This is not an exhaustive list. To avoid possible anxiety please talk to the school before allowing your child to opt for a hair style or piercing that could get them into trouble.

Trousers
Dark grey tailored school trouser with a length that go below the ankle bone. ✓



Trousers ✗
No back pockets, no buckles, no fancy belts, not skinny fitted or sit above the ankle bone
Dark grey tailored trousers with a length that go below the ankle

Skirts
Tartan skirt – knee length. ✓



Skirts ✗
No fitted skirts or skirts that are higher than knee length.

Socks/Tights
With skirt: navy socks or tights
With trousers: grey or black socks ✓



Socks/Tights ✗
No trainers socks, no over the knee socks

Make up
No make- up allowed at all ✓



Make up ✗
No false tan, no tinted moisturiser, no mascara, no tinted eyebrows or lashes, no lipstick, no false eyelashes. No false nails

Hair Standards
Students no dyed hair, short hair must be a number 2 or above. Long hair to be tied back for sports and practical lessons ✓



Hair Standards ✗
No dyed hair at all, no extreme styles, no lines, no skin fades, no engraved hair.

Jewellery
One pair of small gold or silver plain studs in the lower ear lobe ✓



Jewellery ✗
No rings, no chains, no bracelets, no facial piercings, no upper ear piercings, no sparkly earrings.

Shoes
Plain black school shoes ✓



Shoes ✗
No trainers, no pumps, no ballet shoes, no ornamentation, no colour trim

Coats
Plain dark outer coat over blazer ✓



Coats ✗
No hoodies, sports tops, or multi coloured coats. No coats to be worn inside the building.

Rationale for change in PE Kit Supplier – November 2022

The Government published guidance in November 2021 to ensure the cost of school uniform is reasonable and secures the best value for money. Holy Trinity Academy undertook a review of our existing Uniform and PE Kit, which concluded that a new Blazer and PE Kit could be sourced at reduced costs to parents compared to the existing offer. This is the Banner Blazer and Surridge PE Kit.
