What Students told us we are doing well

Students highlighted:

- Many students feel safe in school
- Positive relationships with some trusted adults
- A range of learning approaches (practical, visual, discussion) help understanding
- Opportunities to feel included and develop friendships

"I feel safe in school"

"Using a computer helps me learn better"

"Quiet classrooms help me focus"

"Sometimes teachers don't explain in a way I understand"

Behaviour sanctions are not adapted appropriately	Reviewed policy	Embed SEND-adjusted behaviour approaches as part of the improved information for staff
